I hope you had time during this September school break to bond and recharge with your child/ward. As we begin our last school term of the year, I would like to keep you informed of the important dates in Term 4.

1. Important Dates for Term 4

As the school aims to optimise curriculum time and encourage a culture of continuous learning instead of learning just for the examinations, lessons will resume on 25 October 2023 after the Year-End Assessment. During the said period, the remaining topics for the year will be taught and Clementians will be assessed on their learning before school closes for the year-end holidays. The topics covered during that period will be included in next year's assessment to ensure that Clementians continue to revise what they had learnt in the previous year.

2. Primary 5 Adventure Camp

With the full resumption of camp activities after the easing of Covid-19 safe management measures, we have brought back our P5 level camp. It will be a combined camp with Nan Hua Primary School. Using the outdoors as the 'classroom' for learning and development, we hope that this camp will offer Clementians an opportunity to move out of their comfort zone, foster friendship and build self-confidence.

All information of the camp has been sent in Term 3 to parents of all P5 Clementians.

3. Study Break for Primary 6 Clementians from 25 to 27 September

As communicated via the Parents Gateway (PG) on 25 August, the Ministry of Education will be implementing a study break for Primary 6 students from 25 to 27 September to support their well-being prior to the PSLE.

During the study break, P6 Clementians are strongly encouraged to remain at home and do their revision. Clementians who require assistance from their teachers may arrange for consultations with their teachers in school. In addition, the school may request selected Clementians to return to school during the study break. A PG notification has been sent out to the Clementians who have been selected to return to school during the study break. The school will remain open for P6 Clementians who require in-school support.

Parents/guardians who are unable to secure alternative care arrangements may also approach the school for assistance. The Student Care Centre in school will remain open in the afternoons for families who require the service.

4. Lower Primary Sports Day for Primary 1 to 3 Clementians

Similar to Sports Carnival held earlier in the year, the Lower Primary Sports Day returns this year for our Clementians in P1-P3. Previously, this event was held together with Children's Day celebration but this year, it will be a day on its own, scheduled on 2 November. It will be a fun day specially for our Lower Primary Clementians to engage in activities which require them to apply and hone their fundamental skills. More details will be sent nearer the day of the event.

5. Road Safety

We have received feedback pertaining to the traffic situation outside our main gate during dismissal time. To ensure the safety of all, please do not wait in your vehicle outside the school along Clementi Avenue 3 as this will affect traffic flow. We seek your cooperation to park your vehicle at the nearby HDB car parks and pick your child/ward from school.
